<p>Easy Grow Coir Planting Baskets rom the fibres that surround the shell of a coconut, so they are a natural material for garden lovers. They are also considered very nice in appearance.</p> <p>These Coco Coir hanging basket liners are quite durable and can perhaps be used in a second season. However, as with many types of hanging basket liners, you find that some materials separate too easily, and are taken by birds to line their nests. So, you may come to realise that there is not too much left of the basket to use again next year.</p> <p>The Amateur's Answer Hanging basket liner, in comparison to the Coco Coir material is also very durable. It's a much thinner material than the coir but is also stronger. It is earthy green in colour, so also considered attractive to look at with natural looking colouring.</p> <p>In respect of material qualities, we believe the Amateurs Answer is better as it has superior strength making it last longer.</p>

<i>Product Advantages</i>
<p>The two main ways of planting hanging baskets are <b>side filling</b> and <b>top filling</b>.</p> <p>Top filling hanging baskets is the simplest way of filling any basket. You apply a mix of compost and feed and then apply the plants you want in the top.</p> <p>These can be plants that grow up, grow out or trail right over the side of the hanging basket.</p> <p>Both the Amateur's Answer and the Coco Coir are great for top filling. Both demonstrate good drainage and moisture retention.</p> <p>Side filling is more of a test when it comes to creating a great basket. Affectively, this is a way creating a fuller more rounded display, such as bizzzy Lizzie balls.</p> <p>With the Amateur's Answer this is a hard job made easy, with its thin but stronger material qualities allowing slots to be cut easily in the sides in order to apply plug plants, or even large cell plants.</p> <p>The Coco Coir proves a lot more difficult to get right, with the thicker material harder to slice. You often find that excessive drainage is an issue.</p> <p>Again, we believe that the Amateur's Answer is the best choice liner for planting a hanging basket.</p>

### *Product Application*

This coco liner on roll can be used to fit any size of planter or window box. This co-co is made from nature coconut fibres and has a high moisture capacity as well as been porous allowing airflow and good drainage for excellent root and plant growth. This coir basket liner on roll is easy to cut to size and shape.

### *Product Usage*

- Used for a variety of garden tasks, **landscape fabric** does a fine job holding in soil and moisture and is a smart choice if you already have a roll. Simply cut a length to fit inside your basket. Since it has a tighter weave than other liners, less water escapes, and you may not need to add a sheet of plastic before planting.
